Course Description

Publishing in the peer-reviewed journal is essential to advancing science. On an individual level, publishing is associated with professional development and career advancement. Moreover, graduate programmes require their post graduate students to publish their findings in quality, peerreviewed journals before graduation. However, the graduate students face barriers to publishing their work, including navigating the process of scientific writing and publishing, which can be timeconsuming and cumbersome. On the other hand, given the diverse writing skills of incoming graduate students, writing a scientific paper requires additional formal training, one that includes an elaboration of discipline-specific practices and not merely an enumeration of general effective writing tools. Therefore, there is a clear need for formal training in disciplinary writing to increase the skills required to write an acceptable scientific manuscript. Hence the "Alpha to Omega: The A-Z of Manuscript Writing Workshop for Beginners" is specially designed to help the post graduate students to gain better understanding of the manuscript writing process and to prepared them to handle manuscript rejection.
